SLCC TO THE UNIVERSITY OF UTAH

BECAS DE IVORY HOMES PARA ESTUDIANTES
HISPANOS QUE SE TRANSFERIRAN DE SLCC A LA
UNIVERSIDAD DE UTAH

Hispanic students currently attending Salt Lake Community College who are transferring to the University of Utah and who (1) have completed 30 credit hours or more at the time of their application, (2) have lived in Utah for three or more years, and (3) graduated from a Utah high school, may apply for an Ivory Homes Scholarship. The recipients of these scholarships will receive \$2,000 toward their college expenses during their first year at the University of Utah. These scholarships are only valid at the University of Utah and will be paid out in two installments—one at the start of the fall semester and one at the start of the following spring semester. These scholarships are also being offered to high school graduates in the Salt Lake metropolitan area who have been admitted to attend the University of Utah in the fall.

Students can pick up an application form at the SLCC Multicultural Initiatives Center (4600 S. Redwood Road, Student Center Building) or at the Utah Hispanic Chamber of Commerce. All applications must include the indicated attachments (see below) and must be mailed to the University of Utah (ATTN: Hugh Brown, University of Utah, 195 S. Campus Drive, SLC, UT 84112). Applications will then be forwarded to the Ivory Homes Selection Committee. Students may be eligible for federal financial aid. Call 581-6211 for more information.

Applications must be postmarked no later than February 1st, 2006 for the next academic year. Students wishing help or clarification in filling out the application form below are advised to call Hugh Brown (801-585-1951) at the University of Utah.

Estudiantes Hispanos que están acudiendo Salt Lake Community College y que se transferirán a la Universidad de Utah y (1) han completado 30 horas o más al momento de someter su aplicación, (2) que hayan vivido en Utah por tres años o más, y (3) que se hayan graduado de la escuela secundaria en Utah, pueden aplicar para la Beca de Ivory Homes. Recipientes de esta ayuda financiera recibirán \$2,000 para sus gastos universitarios durante su primer año en la Universidad. Esta ayuda financiera es válida solamente en la Universidad de Utah y será entregada en dos cuotas – una al comienzo del semestre de invierno y la otra al comienzo del semestre de primavera. Estas ayudas financieras también son disponibles para graduados de cualquier escuela secundaria en el área de Salt Lake y quienes son admitidos para ingresar la Universidad de Utah.

Estudiantes pueden recoger su aplicación en la oficina de SLCC Centro de Multicultural Initiatives (4600 S. Redwood Road, edificio Student Center) o en la Cámara de Comercio Hispana de Utah. Los candidatos deben someter los documentos indicados en las instrucciones de la parte inferior de esta aplicación y deben ser enviados a la Universidad de Utah para ser evaluados por el comité de selecciones (Attn: Hugh Brown, 195 S. Campus Drive, SLC, UT 84112). Para más información sobre como recibir ayuda financiera federal comuníquense al 581-6211.
